VICTIM SERVICES PROGRAM

It is the policy of the Pflugerville Police department to observe the rights of crime victims and to ensure they will be treated with fairness, compassion, and dignity. Victim's needs are met through a twenty four hours per day; seven days per week on call victim services program.

The Victim Services Program utilizes community volunteers to provide services to victims and their families, witnesses to the crime, law enforcement personnel, and the community at large. The target population includes all citizens of Pflugerville and all students of the Pflugerville School District. Direct services include:
